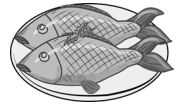

St. Frances Xavier will have a **Lenten Communal Penance Service** on Sunday March 11 at 2:30 PM.

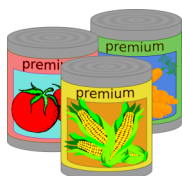
St. Michael will have Confession every Tuesday evening from 6-7 pm during Lent.
