St. Michael will have Confession every Tuesday evening from 6-7 pm during Lent.



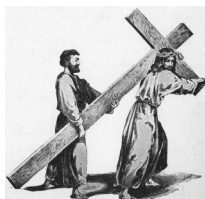
The last Lenten Lunch is at noon Mar. 21st at Wayside Church.
