**(after 9:00 am and 11:30 am Masses)
Feast of St. Blasé, Bishop & Martyr**

The blessing of throats, involving the intercession of St. Blaise, is a very popular devotion. During his lifetime, **St. Blaise** was best known for the miraculous healing of a child who was choking to death on a fishbone. During the blessing of St. Blasé, the priest holds two candles in the form of a cross touching the throat, and prays that through the merits and intercession of St. Blasé the person blessed may be delivered from throat diseases and from every other illness.
