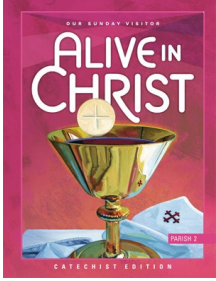

Parkersburg Catholic Schools **Terri Haid Scholarship** award—for the remainder of the 2022-23 school year. Application deadline is November 30, 2022.
