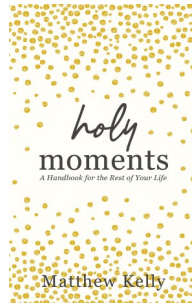

MEETING OF WIDOWS MINISTRY OF ST. MARGARET MARY

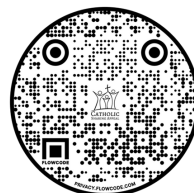
