As the Flu and allergy season is upon us please use the Hand Sanitizer in the Gathering Area. Together we can keep our congregation healthy throughout the winter season.

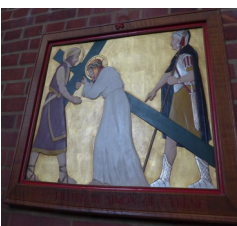
